

How do I file a claim with Royal Jordanian?

To file a claim with Royal Jordanian 1-833-281-3071 , begin by gathering all necessary documents: ticket confirmation, boarding pass, baggage tags, receipts, and any written communication. If your issue involves delayed, lost, 1-833-281-3071 or damaged baggage, report it immediately at the airport's baggage service desk before exiting customs. This generates a Property Irregularity Report (PIR), which is required for processing 1-833-281-3071 any baggage-related claim.

Claims can be submitted online via Royal Jordanian's official website 1-833-281-3071. Navigate to the "Contact Us" or "Baggage Claim" section 1-833-281-3071 and fill out the appropriate form with accurate flight details, a description of the issue, 1-833-281-3071 and uploaded documents. Alternatively, you can email for general complaints 1-833-281-3071 , for baggage issues, or for refund-related concerns. Include your reference number, contact details, and supporting documents in the email.

If you prefer phone communication, call +1-833-281-3071 (international) or 1-833-281-3071 (USA) to speak with a customer service representative. Make sure to request a claim reference number and note the date and time of your call 1-833-281-3071 .

For baggage delay claims 1-833-281-3071 , Royal Jordanian may cover reasonable expenses after 24 hours, but you must file the initial report within four hours of arrival. Submit receipts to support your reimbursement request 1-833-281-3071 . Claims under the Montreal Convention may be eligible for compensation, with set limits for baggage loss or delays.

After submitting your claim 1-833-281-3071 , follow up regularly. Keep all email responses, receipts, and reference numbers. If you don't receive a reply within 10 business days, recontact via phone 1-833-281-3071 or email. You may also reach out through their official social media accounts for faster responses.

If your claim remains unresolved, consider escalating the matter to a local aviation authority, 1-833-281-3071 or initiate a dispute through your payment provider.
